ORDINANCE NO. 2012-204

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DYER, TENNESSEE, TO CREATE TITLE 17, SECTION 106 OF THE DYER MUNICIPAL CODE PERTAINING TO A SOLID WASTE FUND.

WHEREAS, the City of Dyer has established a Solid Waste Department which is responsible for the collection, transport, and disposal of solid wastes produced by the citizens of the community; and

WHEREAS, the Dyer Solid Waste Department generates revenues through the implementation of a fee schedule to be paid for the services it provides; and

WHEREAS, the Dyer City Council has determined it to be sound financial management and in the public interest to create a Solid Waste Fund into which all revenues generated by the Solid Waste Department shall be deposited and from which all expenditures of the Solid Waste Department shall be made.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DYER, TENNESSEE, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. <u>Solid waste fund created</u>. There is hereby created a Solid Waste Fund for the City of Dyer. The Solid Waste Fund shall be the depository for all revenues generated by the Solid Waste Department and shall be the source for all expenditures made by the Solid Waste Department. The City Recorder shall, within thirty (30) days of the effective date of this Ordinance, show proof that a Solid Waste Fund has been created at the bank serving as the City's depository and that financial records have been created to reflect all transactions involving the Solid Waste Fund.
- 2. <u>Use of solid waste funds</u>. No officer or employee of the City of Dyer shall permit the funds of the Solid Waste Fund to be used for any purpose except those approved in the annual budget, and any amendments thereto, for the operation of the Solid Waste Department. Funds committed to the Solid Waste Fund shall be not be co-mingled or deposited with any other municipal fund; except that nothing in this Ordinance shall be construed to prohibit the use of Solid Waste Funds to reimburse the general fund for pro-rata administrative overhead and management of the Solid Waste Department.
- **3.** Addition to the Dyer Municipal Code. Sections 1 and 2 of this Ordinance shall be added as Section 17-106 to the Dyer Municipal Code.

- 4. <u>Effective date</u>. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its date of enactment by the Dyer City Council.
- **5.** <u>Repealer</u>. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances found to be inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
