

ORDINANCE NO. 2005-145

**AN ORDINANCE FOR THE CITY OF DYER TO ADOPT BY
REFERENCE STATE TRAFFIC OFFENSES AND RULES OF THE ROAD**

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Alderpersons desires to adopt by reference the state traffic offenses and rules of the road; and


WHEREAS, the Tennessee Code Annotated 55-10-307 provides that any incorporated municipality may adopt by reference any of the appropriate provisions of the state traffic offenses and rules of the road;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED as follows:

Section 1. That the following provision be added to Title 11, Chapter 9 of the Municipal Code of the City of Dyer:

Section 11-901. Adoption of state traffic statutes and regulations. All violations of state regulations for the operation of vehicles committed within the corporate limits of the municipality and which state law defines are hereby designated and declared to be offenses against the City of Dyer also. This provision shall not apply to any offenses in which the state courts have exclusive jurisdiction.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect immediately after its passage, the public welfare requiring it.
