

ORDINANCE NO. 2005-146

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DYER, TENNESSEE, TO INCREASE
COURT COSTS FOR VIOLATION OF CITY ORDINANCES**


WHEREAS, the cost for violating certain ordinances in the City of Dyer are unrealistically low and appear to pay a very minor part of the cost that the City incurs in providing a city court and police protection: and,

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND
ALDERPERSONS OF THE CITY OF DYER, TENNESSEE** as follows:

Section 1. That the following provision be added to Title 3, Chapter 5 of the Municipal Code of the City of Dyer:

Section 3-501. Court Cost. The court costs to be used by the city judge in assessing the bill of costs in cases in the city court shall be \$62.00. Such court costs shall be in addition to any special court costs that may be assessed under the provisions of the municipal charter.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage the public welfare requiring it.
