

## ORDINANCE NO 2008-161

### **AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TEXT OF THE DYER MUNICIPAL FLOOD DAMAGE PREVENTION ORDINANCE TO CHANGE ORDINANCE #2008-159 PROVISIONS GOVERNING FLOOD HAZARD DISTRICTS, ARTICLE III, GENERAL PROVISIONS, SECTION B. BASIS FOR ESTABLISHING THE AREAS OF SPECIAL FLOOD HAZARD IN ORDER TO MAINTAIN ELIGIBILITY IN THE NATIONAL FLOOD INSURANCE PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, The Legislature of the State of Tennessee has in Tennessee Code Annotated Section 6-33-101 delegated the responsibility to units of local government to adopt regulations designed to promote the public health, safety, and general welfare of its citizenry; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Alderpersons deems it necessary, for the purpose of promoting the health, safety, morals and general welfare of the City to amend said Ordinance; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen has given due public notice of hearing on said amendment and has held a public hearing; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Dyer, Tennessee, that the text of the Dyer Municipal Flood Damage Prevention be amended in that Article III, Section B., be repealed and replaced by the following:

#### **Section B. Basis for Establishing the Areas of Special Flood Hazard**

The Areas of Special Flood Hazard identified on the Dyer, Tennessee, Federal Emergency Management Agency, Flood Insurance Study (FIS) and Flood Insurance Rate Map (FIRM), Community Panel Numbers 47053C0135D, 47053C0155D, 47053C0145D, 47053C0165D dated November 5, 2008, along with all supporting technical data, are adopted by reference and declared to be a part of this Ordinance.
