

## Ordinance 2010-183

An Ordinance Establishing a Maximum Amount for Purchases Without Public Advertisement and Competitive Bidding

**WHEREAS**, the City of Dyer is subject to the provisions of the "Municipal Purchasing Law of 1983," and

**WHEREAS**, this law has been amended by Chapter No. 269, Public Acts of 1999, permitting municipalities to increase the dollar amount of purchases requiring public advertisement and competitive bidding, and,

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Board of Alderpersons of the City of Dyer, Tennessee has determined that it is in the best interest of the City of Dyer to increase said amount, now therefore

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERPERSONS, THAT:**


**Section 1.** Public advertisement and competitive bidding shall be required for the purchase of all goods and services exceeding an amount of seven thousand five hundred dollars (\$7500.00) except for those purchases specifically exempted from advertisement and bidding by the Municipal Purchasing Act of 1983.

**Section 2.** This ordinance shall take effect from and after its final passage, the public welfare requiring it.
