

RESOLUTION # 2005-150

**RESOLUTION TO AFFIRM COMPLIANCE WITH
FEDERAL TITLE VI REGULATIONS**

WHEREAS, both Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and the Civil Rights Restoration Act of 1987 provide that no person in the United States shall, on the ground of race, color or national origin be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of or be subjected to discriminations under any program or activity receiving federal assistance; and

WHEREAS, the Tennessee Attorney General opined in Opinion No. 92.47 that state and local governments are required to comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act in administering federally funded programs; and

WHEREAS, the Community Development Division of the Tennessee Department of Economic and Community Development administers the Three-Star Program and awards financial incentives for communities designated as Three-Star communities, and

WHEREAS, by virtue of the Tennessee Department of Economic and Community Development receiving federal financial assistance all communities designated as Three-Star communities must confirm that the community is in compliance with the regulations of the Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and the Civil Rights Restoration Act of 1987;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IN RESOLVED, by the City governing body of Dyer, Tennessee, meeting in regular session at Dyer, Tennessee; that

SECTION 1. The legislative body of Dyer, Tennessee declares that the city is in compliance with the federal Title VI regulations.


SECTION 2. The Department of Economic and Community Development may from time to time monitor the city's compliance with Federal Title VI regulations.

SECTION 3. This resolution shall take effect upon adoption, the public welfare requiring it.
