**RESOLUTION TO FILE A 2006
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG)
APPLICATION FOR A
SEWER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENT PROJECT**

WHEREAS: the Department of Housing and Urban Development annually funds the Small Cities CDBG program to provide funds for the benefit of low income persons, and


WHEREAS: the Tennessee Department of Economic and Community Development administers the CDBG program to local governments statewide, and

WHEREAS: elected officials of the City of Dyer, having held a public meeting on November 28, 2005, have determined that a Sewer System Improvement project is the most pressing need that can be addressed with assistance from the CDBG program, and


WHEREAS, with a total project estimated at \$590,670 the City of Dyer wishes to make an application to the CDBG program in the amount of \$490,256.00. The City will provide 17% or \$100,414 towards the project using funds from the Sewer Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor of the City of Dyer is authorized to develop and sign the application for CDBG funds and enter into any and all agreements and assurances necessary to consummate the project.
