

**RESOLUTION 2006-160**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF AN APPLICATION TO THE  
TENNESSEE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT AND CONSERVATION FOR GRANT  
FUNDING FROM THE LOCAL PARK AND RECREATION PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS**, the governing body of the City of Dyer recognizes the importance of recreational opportunities for the citizens of Dyer, and

**WHEREAS**, the governing body of the City of Dyer wishes to implement recreational developments for the existing recreational park property to serve the general public; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Dyer wishes to make application for funds in the amount of \$106,000 to implement said project. This will be \$53,000 (50% LPRF funds and \$53,000 (50%) local funds.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the governing body of the City of Dyer meeting in regular session on this 13<sup>th</sup> day of February 2006, that the Mayor of Dyer is hereby authorized to make and sign an application for LPRF/LWCF funds, authorize any required environmental documentation, and enter into any and all contracts and agreements to consummate the application and implement the said improvements, and

**BE IT ALSO RESOLVED** that the governing body of the City of Dyer affirms that it will provide the necessary means for the proper development, operation, and maintenance of the Park and Recreation system and the proposed improvements within.


Upon a motion by NATHAN REEP, seconded by ROBERT JOHANSON,
