

**A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE INTRODUCTION OF A PRIVATE ACT TO AMEND THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF DYER, TENNESSEE**

**RESOLUTION # 2009-172**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Dyer operates with a Private Act Charter, adopted in 1899; and

**WHEREAS**, Article II, Section 9, paragraph (26) of the Dyer City Charter limits the term of debt financing for water and sewer improvements to a maximum term of twenty-five (25) years; and

**WHEREAS**, the City wishes to apply for a low-interest federal loan for water and wastewater improvements and such financing will involve a term of thirty-eight (38) years; and


**WHEREAS**, the City has prepared a Private Act that will amend the City Charter to permit the acceptance of such long-term federal financing.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DYER, TENNESSEE, AS FOLLOWS:**

The entire membership of the Dyer City Council hereby unanimously request that our legislators who represent the Dyer in the Tennessee General Assembly, introduce and secure passage into law of the attached Private Act amending the Dyer City Charter.






