

RESOLUTION 2010-178

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE INTRODUCTION OF A PRIVATE ACT TO REPEAL THE CITY OF DYER'S PRIVATE ACT CHARTER OF 1899, AND AMENDMENTS THERETO, AND REPLACING IT WITH A MODERN CITY CHARTER DRAFTED BY THE DYER CITY COUNCIL.

WHEREAS, the City of Dyer operates under the terms and conditions of a Private Act Charter adopted in 1899; and


WHEREAS, said Private Act Charter has been amended forty-seven (47) times since its enactment, resulting in a document which is in places inconsistent and often difficult to navigate; and


WHEREAS, the City has prepared a draft Private Act that would replace the original 1899 city charter with a new, more easily understood version and which adds provisions for the appointment of a vice mayor.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DYER, TENNESSEE, AS FOLLOWS:

The entire membership of the Dyer City Council hereby unanimously request that our legislators who represent the Dyer in the Tennessee General Assembly, introduce and secure passage into law of the attached Private Act to replace the Dyer City Charter.






