Motion made by Roger Gray seconded by Robert Johnson to approve the August 13, 2007 meeting minutes as written and the August 27, 2007 meeting minutes as written. Motion carried with all ayes.

Motion made by Judy Baker seconded by Bitsy Gilliland to pay the general accounts of August 27, 2007 for \$14,274.48 and September 10, 2007 for \$38,512.57. Motion carried with all ayes.

Alice Ernest representing the 20<sup>th</sup> Century Club would like to plant trees along the tennis court fence at David Robinson Recreation Park. D & J Nursery will plant trees in March. Once additional information is available she will return to the city for permission to plant these trees.

Randy Parham requests information on the property survey at 123 East Maple Street. He was told the survey was complete and he could look at it following the meeting.

Motion made by Nathan Reed seconded by Tom Lannom to pass on 1<sup>st</sup> reading Ordinance 2007-158 (Dogs & Cats Maximum). Motion carried with 6 ayes and 2 pass (Baker, Gilliland).

Robert Johnson stated that Martha Jane West of 144 Washington Street requests the city clean-out the ditch on her property. She said a tree fell across the ditch during the storm. Motion made by Judy Baker seconded by Nathan Reed to secure an easement to move the tree out of the ditch on Martha Jane West's property at 144 Washing Street. Motion carried with all ayes.
