

The City of Dyer Mayor and Board of Alderpersons met in regular session on Monday, September 24, 2007 at 7:00 p.m. at the City Hall. Those present were Alderpersons – Judy Baker, Bitsy Gilliland, Nathan Reed, Roger Gray, Robert Johnson, Cody Childress, George Fisher and Attorney Hillary Lawler. Those absent include Mayor Scott Jewell and Alderman Tom Lannom.

In the absence of Mayor Scott Jewell motion made by Robert Johnson seconded by Nathan Reed to request Alderperson Judy Baker to act as Mayor over this meeting. Motion carried with 6 ayes and 1 pass (Baker).

Motion made by Nathan Reed seconded by Bitsy Gilliland to approve the September 10, 2007 meeting minutes as written. Motion carried with all ayes.

Motion made by Robert Johnson seconded by Nathan Reed to pay the general accounts of \$14,420.51. Motion carried with all ayes.

Fire Chief Bob Moore reported that on September 10, 2007 the fire department answered a fire call to Dyer Nursing Home. They were testing their alarm system and did not call their alarm company or Dyer's dispatch service that this was a test and not a fire.

He also reported that the heater chamber at the fire station is cracked; therefore, no heat is available for the fire station. Gibson County Utility District will not light this heater until this problem is repaired.

Motion made by Nathan Reed seconded by Robert Johnson to pass on 2nd and final reading Ordinance 2007 – 157 (Pit Bulls & Vicious Dogs). Motion carried with all ayes.

Motion made by Nathan Reed seconded by George Fisher to pass on 2nd and final reading Ordinance 2007 – 158 (Maximum Dogs and Cats). Motion carried with 5 ayes and 1 pass (Gilliland).

Motion made by Nathan Reed seconded by George Fisher to approve PO 5161 to Burnett Fire Equipment for \$1,350.00 for fire truck pump service and testing; PO 5165 to American Development Corp for \$541.05 for chemicals.

Motion made by Robert Johnson seconded by Nathan Reed to no longer rent city equipment for private use effective September 25, 2007. Motion carried with all ayes.

The Water and Sewer Committee meets Monday, October 8, 2007 at 6:00 p.m. at the City Hall.

Motion made by Robert Johnson seconded by Nathan Reed to purchase uniforms in-lieu of renting uniforms for the Maintenance Department for a first year savings of \$619.60. Motion carried with all ayes.
