

The City of Dyer Mayor and Board of Alderpersons met in regular session on Monday, November 26, 2007 at 7:00 p.m. at the City Hall. Those present were Mayor Scott Jewell; Alderpersons – Judy Baker, Bitsy Gilliland, Nathan Reed, Roger Gray, Robert Johnson, George Fisher, and Attorney Hillary Lawler. Aldermen Cody Childress and Tom Lannom were absent.

Motion made by Roger Gray seconded by Bitsy Gilliland to approve the November 12, 2007 meeting minutes as written. Motion carried with all ayes.

Motion made by Nathan Reed seconded by Robert Johnson to pay the general accounts of \$16,984.21. Motion carried with all ayes.

Mr. Gary Glisson of 298 High Street presented a city citation to the Mayor to read. It says he is in violation of city ordinances. I think everyone should be treated the same and not single-out certain individuals. He was told in the past to contact Health Officer George Fisher. He contacted Mr. Fisher but says Mr. Fisher has not come by his house. Mr. Fisher went by and looked at Mr. Glisson's yard and asked the police department to contact Mr. Glisson. The police have been unable to contact Mr. Glisson. His ditch property on East South Street needs mowing. Mr. Glisson stated, "If it's my ditch then can I fill it up with dirt?" He was told that he cannot change the natural flow of water. Is it alright for my vehicle to sit in the driveway? He was told the driveway was alright as long as the vehicle does not block the view of traffic leaving East South Street onto High Street.

Clayton Morris of Boy Scout Troop 243 is working on his Eagle Scout Project. He requests permission to plant some trees at David Robinson Recreation Park where the 2006 tornado damaged. He will work with Jimmy Landrum and the Dyer Tree Board.

Motion made by Robert Johnson seconded by Bitsy Gilliland to grant Clayton Morris permission to plant trees at David Robinson Recreation Park. Motion carried with all ayes.

Mayor Jewell appointed Lindsey Brown and Jimmy Landrum to the Dyer Tree Board.





Motion carried with all ayes.
