Motion made by Roger Gray seconded by George Fisher to approve the November 26, 2007 meeting minutes as written. Motion carried with all ayes.

Motion made by Robert Johnson seconded by Judy Baker to pay the general accounts of \$108,714.82. Motion carried with all ayes.

Mrs. Alice Ernest representing the 20th Century Club request permission to plant two trees (maple and glaze autumn) in David Robinson Recreation Park west of the tennis court. David Schroeder of Plain and Simple will plant these trees. The mayor and board suggest that Jimmy Landrum be contacted when this work begins.

Motion made by Nathan Reed seconded by Robert Johnson to approve PO 5218 to American Development Corp for \$441.00 for chemicals; PO 5219 to Tennessee Tractor, LLC for \$642.57 for tractor repairs; PO 5223 to Cottrell Electric for \$1,358.93 for water plant and College Street lift station repairs; PO 5228 to Parham Refrigeration for \$449.55 for water plant and city hall repairs. Motion made by Robert Johnson seconded by Roger Gray to donate \$100.00 (as budgeted) to Gibson County High School 2008 Project Graduation. Motion carried with all ayes.




