Clifton Bryant of Broad Street spoke concerning city stickers. Why don't all people purchase city stickers in Dyer? Some of my neighbors have never purchased a city sticker. If this law is not enforced, then abolish it. I think you should contact the County Clerk and let them sell you stickers when they sell the license plate.

Clyde Hood of North Main Street spoke concerning product disposal. First I would like to commend the Mayor and Board for doing a good job running the city. It is unlawful for the garbage company to collect and dispose of tires, shingles, and batteries. My neighbor is a contractor and following the tornado of 2006, he removed shingles and dumped them in his backyard. I contacted EPA in Washington and was referred to the Commissioner in Nashville. I think he should remove these shingles and recycle them in Trenton. These shingles should be removed and properly disposed.




