

The City of Dyer Board of Mayor and Alderpersons met in regular session Monday, April 28, 2008 at 7:00 p.m. at the City Hall. Those present were Mayor Scott Jewell Alderpersons – Judy Baker, Nathan Reed, Roger Gray, Robert Johnson, Cody Childress, George Fisher and Attorney Hillary Lawler. Bitsy Gilliland and Tom Lannom were absent.

Motion made by Roger Gray seconded by Nathan Reed to approve the April 14, 2008 meeting minutes as written. Motion carried with all ayes.

Clyde Hood of North Main Street spoke concerning product disposal. At the April 14, 2008 meeting Mr. Hood stated that shingles, batteries, or tires are not allowed in the landfill. They must be properly disposed. My neighbor dumped many loads of shingles during the 2006 tornado clean-up in the field next to my fence. I called EPA in Washington then referred to a Commissioner in Nashville then referred to Soil Conversation Environmental Control Solid Waste Division; then Hazardous Waste. This is a fire hazard and hazardous materials. There is no action being done for the removal of these items. The City of Dyer must enforce its code. The governor's office stated this is the city's responsibility. There is a recycle plant in Trenton. I want these shingles moved off the fence row. This is a code violation. Steve Barron dumped these shingles there.

Janice Mealer with city meals-on-wheels program spoke concerning problems with the city van. It leaks oil, water, and gas, and the brakes pull to the left. I deliver 19 meals but increase to 22 next week.

Motion made by Nathan Reed seconded by Robert Johnson to repair the South Main Street lift station at a cost not to exceed \$3,000. Motion carried with all ayes.

Motion made by Robert Johnson seconded by Roger Gray to repair the wastewater plant aerator gear box at a cost not to exceed \$1,700. Motion as amended carried with all ayes.

Motion made by Robert Johnson seconded by Roger Gray to amend the motion to read not to exceed \$2,500. Motion carried with all ayes.

Motion made by Robert Johnson seconded by Judy Baker to authorize the first step in the process to drill two new wells near the water plant. Motion carried with all ayes.

Motion made by Nathan Reed seconded by Robert Johnson to authorize the July 5, 2008 "mini-tractor-pull" north of the playground equipment at David Robinson Recreation Park providing a \$1,000,000 event policy is on file at the City Hall. Motion as amended carried with 5 ayes and 1 abstain (Baker).

Motion made by Nathan Reed seconded by Robert Johnson to amend the motion to require a \$1,000 refundable deposit when the park area is restored to the satisfaction of the city supervisor. Motion carried with 5 ayes and 1 abstain (Baker).

Motion made by Nathan Reed seconded by Roger Gray to approve PO 5346 to Robert's Automotive for \$626.32 for supervisor's truck repairs. Motion carried with all ayes.

Motion made by Nathan Reed seconded by Robert Johnson to approve PO 5350 to Sound Exhaust System for \$452.50 for fire truck repairs. Motion carried with all ayes.


