Motion made by Robert Johnson seconded by Nathan Reed to nominate Alderperson Judy Baker to act as mayor over tonight's meeting. Motion carried with 6 ayes and 1 nay (Baker).

Motion made by Roger Gray seconded by Bitsy Gilliland to approve the August 11, 2008 meeting minutes as written. Motion carried with all ayes.

Jimmy Landrum of 367 Parkview Drive spoke concerning a water hydrant leak at David Robinson Recreation Park. We need to focus on water problems and fix the leak. How many people are in Dyer? 
