
The purpose of this meeting was to discuss the following:

3. City accept or decline audit report


Winston Truett and Stephen Eldridge of Alexander Thompson Arnold, PLLC, of Jackson presented the annual audit report for July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008. The report shows the General Fund expenditures \$156,058 more than their revenues; State Street Aid Fund revenues \$57,736 more than expenditures; other Funds expenditures \$10,183 more than revenues. The Water and Sewer Fund expenditures \$81,160 more than revenues.
