Motion made by Roger Gray seconded by Bitsy Gilliland to approve the March 9, 2009 meeting minutes as written. Motion carried with all ayes.

Motion made by Nathan Reed seconded by Judy Baker to approve the March 16, 2009 special call meeting minutes as written. Motion carried with all ayes.

Mr. Gerald Brewer of 619 North Main Street spoke concerning the ditch behind his house and the fence blocking the water at 607 North Main Street property. The water backs-up into his building. The debris at the fence needs removing where the water can flow to the drainage ditch.

The Mayor declared April 6th through April 11th as Gibson County Pioneer Week with special recognition to the 2009 Lady Pioneers State Basketball Champions and the 2009 Pioneer Cheerleaders as the State Sportsmanship Award.

Motion made by Bitsy Gilliland seconded by Nathan Reed to rescind the February 12, 2007 motion to award Wade Electric Inc a contract for \$90,698 for lighting ball field at David Robinson Recreation Park funded by Local Parks and Recreation Fund Grant. Motion carried with all ayes.




