Motion made by Roger Gray seconded by Jimmy Landrum to approve the August 10, 2009 meeting minutes as written. Motion carried with all ayes.

Mrs. Dorothy Bearce of South Peck Switch Cove spoke concerning the group home construction in her area. We cannot get any information from Nashville. I spoke with Mr. Johnson about the “No Parking” signs for this area. The water stands on the lots where the group home is in process.

Loyd Eno of South Peck Switch Cove spoke concerning the group home construction in his area. The construction company is placing trees in the drainage ditch which will cause flooding in the area. We cannot tell if the building is within the city’s boundaries or not. It only has stakes on the lot now. We can tell more about it once the actual construction starts.

Motion made by Nathan Reed seconded by Robert Johnson to approve PO 5780 to American Development Corp for \$616.50 for water plant bleach and lime. Motion carried with all ayes.

Motion made by Nathan Reed seconded by Jimmy Landrum to approve PO 5784 to Gibson County Soil Conservation District for \$760.00 for a road culvert for North Main Street. Motion carried with all ayes.

Motion made by Judy Baker seconded by Roger Gray to sell the 2000 Chevrolet Police car on govdeals. Motion carried with all ayes.

Motion made by Robert Johnson seconded by George Fisher to advertise and solicit bids for one month on a 2009 Case Backhoe. Motion carried with all ayes.

Motion made by Nathan Reed seconded by George Fisher to pay the general accounts of \$19,615.84. Motion carried with all ayes.
