He offered to sell this property to the city for \$69,200 or will continue the present lease for an additional \$50.00 per month (would prefer the additional \$600.00 paid within the first month to help pay the county and city taxes). I would like an answer by January 1, 2010.

Robert Johnson stated that the city applied for a fire station grant. He was told that Randy Nelson called Mayor Thompson today and the city did not receive this grant.


Bitsy Gilliland asked if this building is still feasible for the fire and police department.


Jimmy Landrum requests the cost to insulate the building.
