Jimmy Landrum will assist Gerald Parrish in writing a Recreation Park Fee Schedule ordinance.

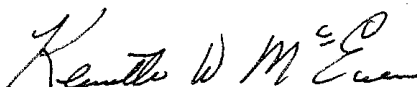
Mayor Thompson request the city alderpersons meet concerning the charter amendments. There will be a meeting Tuesday, February 16, 2010 at 6:30 p.m.

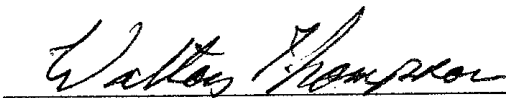
