Mrs. Dorothy Bearce of Peck Switch Cove spoke concerning the construction workers building the two houses in her area. They throw trash, bottles, cans, paper, etc. on the ground and it blows throughout the neighborhood. The workers are mostly non-English speaking people. People use this road as a drag strip, drive too fast, and race to the exit. The posted speed sign should be 20 mph. She request more police patrol through the area. When the workers see a police officer, they slow down.




