Alderman Cody Childress was absent.

Motion made by Roger Gray seconded by Judy Baker to approve the February 22, 2010 meeting minutes as written. Motion carried with all ayes.

Mrs. Maria Hebert of 142 Scattered Acres Drive spoke concerning a drainage problem at her property. She called Mr. Johnson and the city crew did some work last year but did not finish the job. There is a mosquito pond. We would like the drainage work completed.

Mr. Johnson stated that the city did try to help with this problem. This is a major problem and the water needs to follow the ditch to South Main Street. This is very expensive to get the proper fall for the water to drain. The city will need an engineer and easements before we can work on private property.

The water tank at the Industrial Park needs some roof work. George Cottrell will replace 6 panels for \$4,400 or 20 panels for \$8,320.



Motion made by Robert Johnson seconded by George Fisher to purchase seals for a pump at a cost not to exceed \$500. Motion carried with all ayes.


