Committee Reports

Motion made by Finance Committee Chair Ray Carroll to authorize the purchase of a 2015 Ford Explorer from the Missouri State Highway Patrol for \$17,950.00 and to provide up to \$4,000.00 for equipping the vehicle. Motion carried with all ayes.

Parks & Building Committee Chair Michael Barron asked who had control of the lights at the park. Barron is concerned that lights may be left on when not needed. The City Recorder will contact the ball league for information.

Mayor Younger reported that he had spoken with a contractor about flooring for the old ag building. Younger said the contractor said the cost for vinyl will be \$1,500.00 more than for CVT tile. He'll get an official quote to the Mayor, but the expected cost will be \$5,500. Mayor Younger also said that he and Alderman Mikkelsen had looked at the project a few weeks back; Younger asked board members to let him know if they had any ideas of who the City could hire to complete the renovations.
